It Means Counting All The Females We Grow Out Up To A Year Of Age And That We May Never Use For Breeding. We Eventually Place Them For Free In Homes And This Law Counts The Dogs We Take Back For Any Reason. 11 Intact Females If You Bred Them All (Which We Don't) But Just Say We Did Would Average Between 22 And 44 Puppies. At The Highest Count The Amount Of Money You Might Have As Income Would Be 15,000 Dollars At The High Average Puppy Price. Food For These Puppies And All
