

Enforcement Division Staff Report June 26, 2018

Case Highlights

Case No. EAB20170022143

Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation v. LG Camelot, LLC
On January 11, 2018, a default order was entered against LG Camelot, LLC, assessing an administrative penalty of \$2,000 for failing to schedule an inspection within one year of construction completion. The administrative penalty was paid in full.

Case No. EAB20170022138

In the Matter of C/B/K Dominion Ridge SC, Ltd.
On January 31, 2018, an Agreed Order was entered against C/B/K Dominion Ridge SC, Ltd., imposing an administrative penalty of \$1,250 for failing to schedule an inspection within one year of construction completion. The administrative penalty was paid in full.

Case No. EAB20170022765

In the Matter of Brixmor/IA Central Station LLC
On February 21, 2018, an Agreed Order was entered against Brixmor/IA Central Station LLC, imposing an administrative penalty of \$1,000 for failing to schedule an inspection within one year of construction completion. The administrative penalty was paid in full.

Case No. EAB20170021861

In the Matter of MBTT Property 3 LLC
On March 14, 2018, an Agreed Order was entered against MBTT Property 3 LLC, imposing an administrative penalty of \$750 for failing to schedule an inspection within one year of construction completion. The administrative penalty was paid in full.

Case No. EAB20170022755

In the Matter of JMK5 Texas City LLC
On April 25, 2018, an Agreed Order was entered against JMK5 Texas City LLC, imposing an administrative penalty of \$1,000 for failing to schedule an inspection within one year of construction completion. The administrative penalty was paid in full.

Organizational Changes

- The name of the Division has changed from Compliance to the Regulatory Program Management Division (RPM). David Gonzales is the new Director of RPM and Lee Parham is the new Deputy Director of RPM.
- Charlotte Melder has been selected as the Regulatory Program Manager for the Business and Consumer Safety Section, effective June 15th. Charlotte comes to RPM with almost 10 years of experience, as a Senior Prosecutor. She will help oversee the Architectural Barriers Program.

Public Outreach and Education

- Architectural Barriers (AB) met with the Technical Memorandum Work Group.
- The two-day Texas Accessibility Academy was presented in Austin April 10-11, 2018. Norman Kieke and Crisi Cooper taught the class. Mike Fleharty handled registration and confirmation and was present to assist with logistics and to handle technical questions. Fifty-two people attended.
- The Building Professional Institute has been conducted two times in recent months; February 19-21, 2018 in Houston and May 21-23, 2018 in Irving. Classes include two four-hour sessions; Understanding TAS and Applying TAS. The two-day Texas Accessibility Academy is also part of the BPI curriculum. Almost eighty people attended the Houston classes. The Irving classes had over 210 in attendance.
- Texas State Technical College invited Norman Kieke and Crisi Cooper to address students in a Codes Class to talk about TAS and the career opportunities as a Registered Accessibility Specialist. TDLR Commissioner Helen Callier has offered to contact additional schools to inquire about similar presentations with architecture students.
- Several AB staff attended select portions of the February 2018 annual meeting of the Accessibility Professionals Association in Austin.
- The Texas Governor's Committee on People with Disabilities met April 26, 2018 at Texas State University. Norman Kieke represented TDLR and the AB Program at the meeting.

Projects

- Regulatory Program Management Division staff are diligently working with Software Development Services on Texas Architectural Barriers System (TABS), a replacement for the legacy software database tracking program currently in use.
- To prepare for the conversion to TABS, AB staff led by Marsha Godeaux and Laura Montes conducted a third and final file round up on February 2, 2018 in an effort to close project records.
- In an effort to maintain a safe working environment, TDLR safety officers (including the AB Program representatives) participated in a session on Active Shooter Training.
