**Application – Areas Used Only by Employees as Work Areas  
4.1.1(3)**

In vehicle service / repair facilities, such as oil change/lube centers, the employee work area is considered to begin at the door (pedestrian or overhead) that the employees use to enter the garage. This allows the service / garage area (including bays and pits) to be exempt entirely except for approach / enter/ exit requirements.

The position of this department is taken further to include the intent of the work area beginning at the door to the workplace.

This would not apply to “other” work areas within a work area such as an office, conference room or other common use spaces not specific to the task.
