**Accessible Fixtures – Located Within Toilet Stalls**

**Scoping and Application  
4.1.3(11), 4.22.6, 4.23.6**

TAS 4.22.6 and 4.23.6 require at least one lavatory and mirror, if provided, to comply with 4.19 and does not allow the only accessible lavatories and mirrors to be located within accessible toilet stalls unless other accessible lavatories and mirrors are provided in the common area of the toilet room, bathroom, bathing facility or shower room.

TDLR is applying this same position to other types of fixtures and dispensers such as (but not limited to) urinals, diaper changing tables, dispensers, bathtubs and showers.

If other types of fixtures or dispensers as described above are provided in the accessible stall in addition to those in the common space, they shall be accessible and not interfere with the clear space required for any one fixture in the accessible stall.
