

## Summary of Proposed Rule Changes

The Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation proposes changes to the rules at 16 TAC, Chapter 75, Air Conditioning and Refrigeration.

### What are the proposed rule changes?

The proposed rule changes:

- Update the International Residential Code, International Mechanical Code, International Fuel Gas Code, and Uniform Mechanical Code editions that are effective in the state of Texas from the 2018 editions to the 2021 editions. The 2018 code editions will remain in effect only through August 31, 2024.
