Case Highlights

- **Randall Lusby** (ATH20180016617)
An Agreed Order was issued March 25, 2019. On March 25, 2019, an Agreed Order was entered against Randall Lusby assessing a \$750.00 administrative penalty for two violations. First, Mr. Lusby was found to be performing the activities of an athletic trainer without holding a license. Second, Mr. Lusby was found to be holding himself out as an athletic trainer without holding a license to do so. Both are Class D violations according to the Department's Enforcement Plan. Mr. Lusby remitted payment in full for the penalty assessed for the violations on March 12, 2019.

- **Clayton Prosser** (ATH20190011908)
On September 17, 2019, an Agreed Order was entered against Clayton Prosser assessing a \$375.00 administrative penalty for engaging in sexually exploitive behavior with a person receiving services from him. This is a Class D violation according to the Department's Enforcement Plan. Mr. Prosser remitted payment for the penalty in full on August 19, 2019.

Advisory Board of Athletic Trainers Meeting
December 2, 2019**

Program Update

- Medical and Health Professions Section staff have been assisting Customer Service with email responses to applicants and licensees.
- Representatives from the Texas State Athletic Trainers Association met with TDLR executive and program staff to discuss initiatives regarding the apprenticeship method to licensure and possible updates to statutory language concerning practice settings.
- Regulatory Program Management staff are currently working with Bill Implementation Teams (BIT) to integrate legislative changes from the 86th Texas Legislature. The bill teams are working to develop draft proposed rules, which will be presented to the advisory board and discussed at a future advisory board meeting. The bill teams will also be updating webpages, forms, applications, and other program material, as needed, to reflect statutory changes.
