Dear Applicant:

Enclosed is an application for a Texas Barber Provisional License. A Provisional Barber License allows the holder to practice barbering in the state of Texas for 180 days. To be eligible for a Provisional Barber License you must submit the following:

- 1. Provisional License Fee of \$45.00**
- 2. Provisional Application, completed in full**
- 3. Copy of current license OR picture ID**

A Provisional Barber License is non-renewable.

If you intend to work in Texas for longer than 180 days, you must apply for and receive a reciprocal Texas Barber License before the Provisional Barber License expires.

To download an application for a reciprocal Texas Barber License, visit our website at www.license.state.tx.us. If all requirements are met, a reciprocal Texas Barber License will be issued and will be valid for two years from the date of issuance.

Pursuant to an emergency rule adopted by the Texas Commission of Licensing and Regulation on September 8, 2005, eligible persons can obtain a provisional license to practice as a barber in Texas by meeting the application requirements and paying a \$45.00 fee. The Provisional Barber License is limited to barber applicants who are displaced as a result of Hurricane Katrina. The Commission also exempted barbers displaced as a result of Hurricane Katrina from the Booth Rental Permit requirement.
