TDLR COMMISSION APPOINTS MEMBERS TO ADVISORY BOARD ON BARBERING

The Texas Commission of Licensing and Regulation on Thursday, September 29, 2005, appointed five members to an advisory board that will represent the interests of the barbering profession in matters that come before the Commission.

“These new board members will play a crucial role providing the technical expertise we need as we review and redraft the barbering rules this fall,” said Commission Chairman Leo Vasquez of Houston, who appointed board members with the approval of the full Commission. “I believe they represent a good cross-section of the profession. All recommendations for rule changes and updates, as well as other matters affecting the profession, will be reviewed and considered by this board before they are heard by the Commission. Their recommendations will be given great weight by the Commission.”

Senate Bill 411, which was passed by the 79th Texas Legislature, transferred regulation of the barbering profession to the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation (TDLR) effective September 1, 2005. That law also designated the makeup of the advisory board. Board members will serve staggered six-year terms.

The new members are:

Advisory Board on Barbering

- Two barbershop owners who hold a Barbershop Permit:
Linda G. Connor, of Austin. Ms. Connor also was appointed presiding officer of the Board.
Aldene (Dean) Hudson Jr., of Arlington.
- Two Class A Barbers who do not hold a Barbershop Permit:
Joseph B. Grondin, of Round Rock.
Dwayne Childers Jr., of Waco.
- One member who holds a permit to conduct or operate a barber school:
Ronald Brown, of Dripping Springs.
