

## Summary of Proposed Rule Changes

The Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation proposes changes to the rules at 16 TAC, Chapter 121, Behavior Analyst.

### What are the proposed rule changes?

The proposed rule changes:

- Implement House Bill (HB) 3743, Section 4, 88<sup>th</sup> Legislature, Regular Session (2023), which exempts the Commission and the Department's advisory boards from Texas Government Code, Chapter 2110, State Agency Advisory Committees.
- Remove language from Chapter 121, Behavior Analyst, that states that Texas Government Code, Chapter 2110 applies to the Behavior Analyst Advisory Board.
- Remove conflicting language and align the Behavior Analyst program rules with Texas Occupations Code, Chapter 51, the Commission and Department's enabling statute, as amended by HB 3743, Section 4.
