Occupations Code, Chapter 451

Sec. 451.051. **BOARD; MEMBERSHIP.** (b) The board consists of five members appointed by the presiding officer of the commission with the approval of the commission as follows:

- (1) three members who are athletic trainers; and
- (2) two members who represent the public.

Sec. 451.0521. **DUTIES OF BOARD.**

The board shall provide advice and recommendations to the department on technical matters relevant to the administration of this chapter.

Sec. 451.053 **VACANCY.** (b) If a vacancy occurs on the board, the presiding officer of the commission, with the commission's approval, shall appoint a replacement who meets the qualifications for the vacant position to serve for the unexpired portion of the term.

Sec. 451.055. **PRESIDING OFFICER.**

The presiding officer of the commission shall designate a member of the board to serve as the presiding officer of the board for a one-year term. The presiding officer of the board may vote on any matter before the board.

Sec. 451.056. **MEETINGS.**

The board shall meet at the call of the presiding officer of the commission or the executive director.

**Public Member Requirements:**

A person may not be a public member of the board if the person or the person's spouse:

1. Is registered, certified or licensed by TDLR in the industry or occupation under the jurisdiction of the advisory board or in a related industry or occupation;
2. Is employed by or participates in the management of a business entity or other organization regulated by or receiving money from TDLR in the industry or occupation under the jurisdiction of the advisory board or in a related industry or occupation;
3. Owns or controls, directly or indirectly, more than a 10 percent interest in a business entity or other organization regulated by or receiving money from TDLR in the industry or occupation under the jurisdiction of the advisory board or in a related industry or occupation;
4. Uses or receives a substantial amount of tangible goods, services, or money from TDLR other than reimbursement authorized by law for board membership, attendance or expenses; or
5. Is a TDLR employee.
