Occupations Code, Chapter 701
Effective 9/1/2015

SECTION 1.192. The heading to Subchapter B, Chapter 701, Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows:

SUBCHAPTER B. DIETITIANS ADVISORY BOARD

Sec. 701.051. DIETITIANS ADVISORY BOARD MEMBERSHIP.

SECTION 1.193. Section 701.051, Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows:

(a) The advisory board consists of nine members appointed by the presiding officer of the commission with the approval of the commission as follows:

(1) six licensed dietitian members, each of whom has been licensed under this chapter for not less than three years before the member's date of appointment; and

(2) three members who represent the public.

(b) In appointing dietitian members to the advisory board, the presiding officer of the commission shall attempt to maintain balanced representation among the following primary areas of expertise included in the professional discipline of dietetics:

(1) clinical;

(2) educational;

(3) management;

(4) consultation; and

(5) community.

(c) Appointments to the advisory board shall be made without regard to the race, color, disability, sex, religion, age, or national origin of the appointee.

SECTION 1.194. Subchapter B, Chapter 701, Occupations Code, is amended by adding Section 701.0511 to read as follows:

Sec. 701.0511. DUTIES OF ADVISORY BOARD.

The advisory board shall provide advice and recommendations to the department on technical matters relevant to the administration of this chapter.

SECTION 1.195. Section 701.054, Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 701.054. TERMS; VACANCIES.

(a) Members of the advisory board serve staggered six-year terms. The terms of three members begin on September 1 of each odd-numbered year.

(b) If a vacancy occurs during a member's term, the presiding officer of the commission, with the commission's approval, shall appoint a replacement who meets the qualifications for the vacant position to serve for the remainder of the term.

SECTION 1.196. Section 701.057, Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 701.057. PRESIDING OFFICER.

The presiding officer of the commission shall designate a member of the advisory board as the presiding officer of the advisory board to serve for a term of one year. The presiding officer of the advisory board may vote on any matter before the advisory board.

SECTION 1.197. Section 701.058, Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 701.058. MEETINGS.

The advisory board shall meet at the call of the presiding officer of the commission or the executive director.

Public Member Requirements:

A person may not be a public member of the board if the person or the person's spouse:

1. Is registered, certified or licensed by TDLR in the industry or occupation under the jurisdiction of the advisory board or in a related industry or occupation;
2. Is employed by or participates in the management of a business entity or other organization regulated by or receiving money from TDLR in the industry or occupation under the jurisdiction of the advisory board or in a related industry or occupation;
3. Owns or controls, directly or indirectly, more than a 10 percent interest in a business entity or other organization regulated by or receiving money from TDLR in the industry or occupation under the jurisdiction of the advisory board or in a related industry or occupation;
4. Uses or receives a substantial amount of tangible goods, services, or money from TDLR other than reimbursement authorized by law for board membership, attendance or expenses; or
5. Is a TDLR employee.
