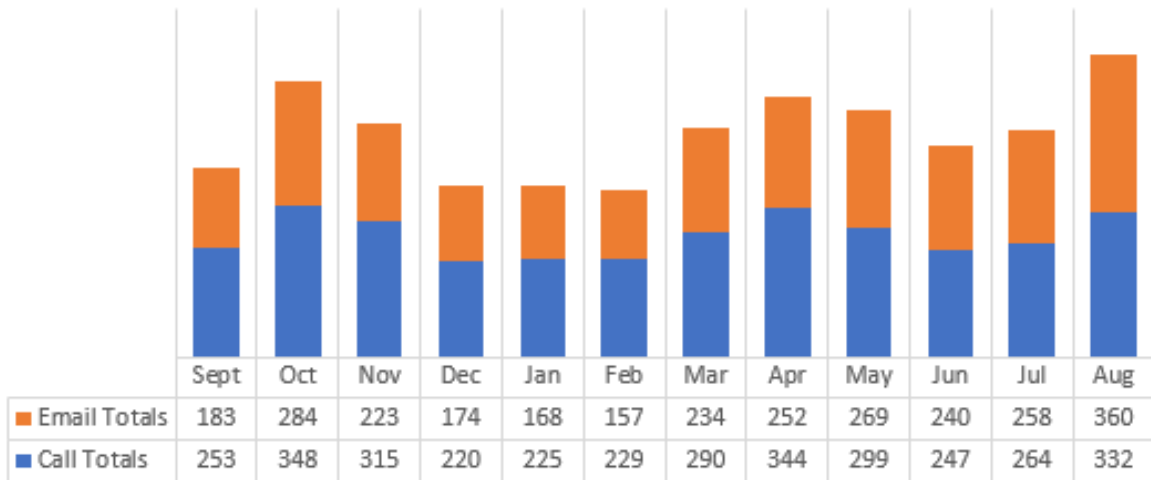

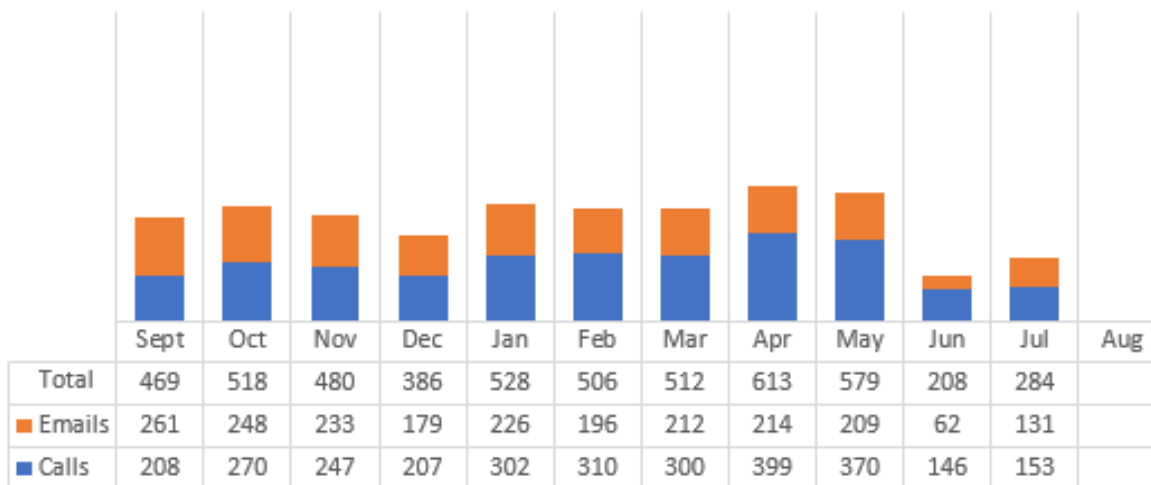

BOARD OF BOILER RULES

Enforcement Division Staff Report August 19, 2019

Case Highlights

- On March 4, 2019, an Agreed Order was entered into against Scott A. Ankeney. Mr. Ankeney was found to have performed repairs on a boiler without holding an “R” certificate of authorization from the National Board of Boilers and Pressure Vessel Inspectors. Mr. Ankeney was witnessed to have been grinding on welds during the course of the repair work. Mr. Ankeney agreed to pay an administrative fine of \$3000. That fine has been paid in full.
- On December 12, 2018, an Agreed Order was entered against owner/operator Emtape 2, LLC. Respondent was found to have failed to comply with an order of a boiler inspector. An inspection was performed, and it was determined that the boiler had a faulty chimney B venting tube due to severe corrosion and emitting carbon monoxide. The boiler was deemed unsafe and red tagged. One day later, the inspector went back out to the facility and found the boiler had been in use in violation of the red tag. The case was originally set for a hearing on October 25, 2018. On the day of the hearing, Respondent entered into a settlement agreement with the Department. Respondent was assessed a \$1,000 fine. The fine had been paid in full.

REGULATORY PROGRAM MANAGEMENT DIVISION REPORT

Board of Boiler Rules Meeting

Monday, August 19, 2018 – 1:30 p.m.

Organizational Changes

- Deputy Boiler Inspector William Vanhook was promoted to Inspection Specialist for the North Texas Region. Mr. Vanhook has already earned the National Board Authorized Inspector Commission. He also has met all the requirements to earn the National Board Team and ASME Team Leader Certifications, his applications have been submitted to the applicable agencies.
- The Deputy Boiler Inspector Joe Rodriguez who was assigned to the El Paso region retired on Nov. 30, 2018. With the retirement of Robert Shirley and promotion of William Vanhook, this left 3 Deputy Boiler Inspector positions open. These positions were filled by:
 - Deputy Boiler Inspector Jay Kim-El Paso region. Mr. Kim came to TDLR from Authorized Inspection Agency Hartford Steam Boiler. Mr. Kim already had many years of performing boiler inspections under his belt and had already earned the National Board In-Service Commission with the “R” Endorsement and Texas In-Service Commission. Due to these credentials, Mr. Kim was out conducting boiler inspections in his assigned area within a month.
 - Deputy Boiler Inspector Joey Burgess-Dallas/Ft. Worth region. Mr. Burgess came to TDLR from Authorized Inspection Agency Liberty Mutual. Mr. Burgess already had many years of performing boiler inspections under his belt and had already earned the National Board In-Service Commission and Authorized Inspector Commission with the “R” & “B” Endorsement and Texas In-Service and ASME Commission. Due to these credentials, Mr. Kim was out conducting boiler inspections in his assigned area within a month. Because Mr. Burgess already had the National Board Authorized Inspector Commission with “B” Endorsement, we sent him to Team Leader school with Mr. Vanhook. Mr. Burgess also met all the requirements to earn the National Board Team and ASME Team Leader Certifications, his applications have been submitted to the applicable agencies.
 - Deputy Boiler Inspector Dennis Summers-Dallas/Ft. Worth region. Mr. Summers came to TDLR with many years’ experience in the operation of boilers. Since starting with TDLR he has earned his Texas In-Service Commission and has been released to conduct boiler inspections on his own.

Public Outreach – Trainings, Attendance at Industry and Association Meetings and other outreach activities

- Chief Inspector Rob Troutt attended: NBIC Code Meeting the weeks of 1/14/19 and 7/15/19; ASME Code Week the weeks of 7/30/18; ASME Code Week the week of 2/11/19, 5/6/19 and 8/3/19; National Board, Board of Trustees Meetings the weeks of 1/28/19 and 8/12/19. Chief Inspector Troutt is the Chairman of the Subcommittee for NBIC, Repairs and Alterations, a member of ASME Conformity Assessment, ASME Section IV Main Committee and Subgroups Welded Boilers and Water Heaters, the Chair of ASME Section VI Main Committee and a Member at Large for the National Board, Board of Trustees.
- William Vanhook gave a presentation in Pharr Texas to Fire Department Officials, Building Officials and General Contractor on the requirement of Texas Boiler and Rules. There were approximately 50 attendees.

Inspection Statistics

- The average number of monthly boiler inspections has been steady since the last board meeting. The total number of Overdue Boilers is at 1,498 boilers as of Aug. 1, with 833 of those boilers greater than 90 days overdue. Effective on September 1, we will start issuing inspection orders on these boilers as permitted by Texas boiler Rules 65.91. The number of Joint Reviews conducted monthly has been much higher since the last report. Once the Certifications for Mr. Vanhook and Mr. Burgess are received from ASME and NB, TDLR will have 6 ASME and NB Team Leaders (this is more than ever in the history of TDLR).
