Subj: PHP Boilers

Ref: Texas Boiler Administrative Rule: 16 TAC § 65.2(29) – Heating Boiler

The referenced rule defines a heating boiler as "A steam heating boiler, hot water heating boiler, hot water supply boiler, or potable water heater that is directly fired with oil, gas, solar energy, electricity, coal, or other solid or liquid fuel."

HTP, Inc. has installed numerous non-ASME Code boilers at Pilot truck stop locations in Texas over the past five years. (Photo of a unit included on Page 2.) The Chief Inspector has agreed to allow the company to de-rate the units by replacing controlling circuit boards and labels; this must be witnessed by a Texas-commissioned inspector and reported to Austin TDLR staff and the Team Lead.¹
