### **TDLR COMMISSION APPOINTS MEMBERS TO ADVISORY BOARD ON COSMETOLOGY**

The Texas Commission of Licensing and Regulation on Thursday, September 29, 2005, appointed five members to an advisory board that will represent the interests of the cosmetology profession in matters that come before the Commission.

“These new board members will play a crucial role providing the technical expertise we need as we review and redraft the cosmetology rules this fall,” said Commission Chairman Leo Vasquez of Houston, who appointed the board members with the approval of the full Commission. “I believe they represent a good cross-section of the profession. All recommendations for rule changes and updates, as well as other matters affecting the profession, will be reviewed and considered by this board before they are heard by the Commission. Their recommendations will be given great weight by the Commission.”

Senate Bill 411, which was passed by the 79<sup>th</sup> Texas Legislature, transferred regulation of the cosmetology profession to the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation (TDLR) effective September 1, 2005. That law also designated representation on the advisory board. Board members will serve staggered six-year terms.

The new members are:

#### **Advisory Board on Cosmetology**

- One member who holds a beauty shop license and is not part of a chain of beauty shops:  
**Clive Lamb, of Addison. Mr. Lamb also was appointed Presiding Officer of the Board.**
- One member who holds a beauty shop license and is part of a chain of beauty shops:  
**Allison Leigh Kincy, of Carrollton.**
- One member who holds a beauty culture school license:  
**Glenda Jemison, of Houston.**
- Two members who hold an operator's license:  
**Kerin Haney, of Georgetown.**  
**Zelda Moore, of Cedar Park.**
