



**Update and discussion regarding Dietitians program activities**

- Medical and Health Professions Section staff have been assisting Customer Service with email responses to applicants and licensees.
- Regulatory Program Management staff are currently working with Bill Implementation Teams (BIT) to integrate legislative changes from the 86<sup>th</sup> Texas Legislature. The two bills that passed related to the Dietitians program are House Bill 2847 and House Bill 2059. House Bill 2847, Article 12, removes the requirement to adopt an official seal and removes duplicative sanction provisions. House Bill 2059 requires certain health care practitioners to successfully complete human trafficking prevention training as a condition of license renewal. The bill teams are working to develop draft proposed rules that will be presented to the Board and discussed at a future advisory board meeting.
- Regulatory Program Management and General Counsel staff supported the Telehealth workgroup that met in July 2018. The workgroup update will be provided during agenda item G. The Standard of Care workgroup has not met since the last advisory board meeting.

**Medical & Health Professions Section Update**

- Medical and Health Professions Section staff issued the most recent edition of the TDLR Health Monitor in September 2019.
- New staff: Mary Hoffman returned to the Medical and Health Professions Section, and Steve Uecker joined the team in September 2018. Mary will be the lead for the Dietitians Program, with Stewart Myrick serving as the program backup.
