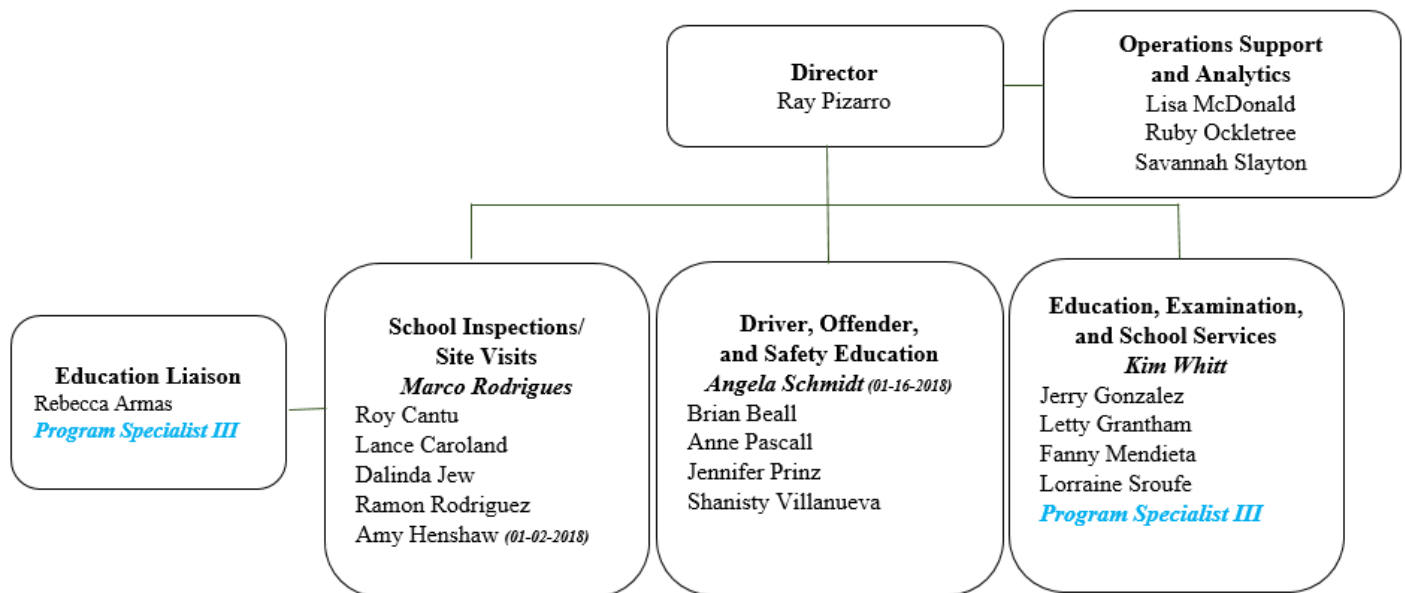

Current Projects

- Parent Taught Driver Education (PTDE) Guide Update
Ford Strawn revised the PTDE Guide to present information in a more concise and chronological manner. Redundant and confusing information was removed.
- Ford revised the PTDE Designation form and sent the new form to DPS, integrated it into the PTDE Guide and ensured it was hosted on TDLR's website.
- Developed ESC6 presentation
Ford is conducting presentations at Education Service Center (ESC) 6 conferences starting in March for DE instructor Continuing Education and Legislative Initiatives.
- Driving Safety Certificates
Based on a need in response to SB 848/HB 912, Ford is developing a standardized certificate for electronic issuance. This is to standardize the documents received in the court and help mitigate fraud and counterfeiting.

Public Outreach

- Crossroads Coalition Meetings
On November 2, 2017 and January 11, 2018, Ford and John Schildwachter participated in the Crossroads Coalition meetings and made contact with Texas Municipal Court Education Center (TMCEC) representative(s) to provide input and disseminate information to courts for electronic DS issuance.
- International Assistance Opportunity
In January, TDLR was contacted by a representative of Business Development for Laureate Vocational in Saudi Arabia to discuss assistance with initiating the first driver education program for women drivers, based on the Texas driver education model. Initiation of this project is under discussion.

Training

- E&E Inspector Overview
On December 13, 2017, Ford conducted follow up training and a Q&A session with E&E inspectors.
- Enforcement Prosecutor Training
On January 3, 2018, Ford provided training for three new Enforcement Division Prosecutors on the Driver Education & Safety Program's background, procedures and requirements.
