SB 30: INFORMATION RELATING TO THE COMMUNITY SAFETY ACT STATEMENT OF ASSURANCE

Effective September 1, 2018, Senate Bill 30, 85th Regular Session, requires each driver education school, parent taught course provider, and driving safety course provider to include information relating to citizen and law enforcement interaction procedures for traffic stops in their curricula.

The Community Safety Education Act video is 16 minutes in length and is available along with a presentation for instructors at www.tdlr.texas.gov/driver/river.htm#communitysafety

The Community Safety Education Act video, and instructional presentation, is required to be shown in all driving safety and driver education courses. This information must be included in Module 4 in the Minor and Adult Course and in Topic 7 in the Adult 6-hour course.
