STATEMENT OF ASSURANCE

House Bill 105: Information Relating to Oversize and Overweight Vehicles

Effective **September 1, 2019**, House Bill 105, 86th Regular Session, requires that driver education and driving safety curriculum include **information relating to oversize and overweight vehicles**.

This information must include:

- methods of safely operating a motor vehicle near an oversize or overweight vehicle; and
- safe following distances and safe passing methods.

Each driver education school, parent taught course provider, and driving safety course provider is required to:

1. Update their curriculum;
2. Submit an updated curriculum outline to TDLR showing the modules and topics required by HB 105; and
3. Complete and return this Statement of Assurance form to TDLR no later than **September 1, 2020**.
