Escalator and moving walks manufactured by Schindler Elevator Corporation (Schindler), its acquisitions manufactured under Westinghouse Elevator Corporation and Haughton Elevator Co. require three to six steps / pallets be removed to perform necessary periodic inspections and tests of steps/pallets, chains, and trusses (Ref. ASME A17.2 - 2004 thru 2010 Item 8.12.2 and Item 10.12.2.)
