APPRENTICE-IN-TRAINING LASER HAIR REMOVAL APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

You must successfully complete 40 hours of laser hair removal training at a department approved training program. For a list of department approved training programs, [see the training programs page](#).

DOCUMENTS SUBMITTED WITH YOUR APPLICATION WILL NOT BE RETURNED. KEEP A COPY OF YOUR COMPLETED APPLICATION, ALL ATTACHMENTS, AND YOUR CHECK OR MONEY ORDER.

1. NAME – Provide your legal name in the spaces provided. (Last Name, First Name, Middle Name, Suffix) Examples of a suffix include Jr., Sr., and II. (Mr. is not a suffix.)
2. GENDER – Select whether you are male or female.
3. DATE OF BIRTH – Provide your birthdate. A person must be at least 18 years of age to qualify to be a laser hair removal apprentice-in-training.
4. DO YOU HAVE A SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER – Check YES or NO to indicate if you have been issued or assigned a Social Security Number by the Social Security Administration.
5. SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER – Provide your Social Security Number. Social Security Number disclosure is required by Section 231.302(c)(1) of the Texas Family Code to obtain a license. Your Social Security Number is subject to disclosure to an agency authorized to assist in the collection of child support payments. 6. EMAIL ADDRESS – Provide your email address only if you agree to the following statement. By providing my email address I authorize the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation (TDLR) to send licensing communications and required notices to me by electronic mail. I understand that I may revoke this authorization in writing and that I must update my email address or I will not receive these notices. I understand that the email address I have provided in this application will remain confidential except as permitted or required by law.
7. PHONE NUMBER – Provide a telephone number, including the area code, where we can reach you during the day. This may be your office phone number where we can leave a message.
8. MAILING ADDRESS – Provide your current mailing address. This is the address where we will send you mail. This address can be a post office box. You can add the zip plus-4 to help the postal service deliver mail more efficiently and accurately.
9. CRIMINAL HISTORY – Indicate if you have ever been convicted of or placed on deferred adjudication for any Misdemeanor or Felony, other than a minor traffic violation. If YES, complete and attach a Criminal History Questionnaire for each offense. This form can be obtained from the TDLR website at www.tdlr.texas.gov/MISC/lic002.pdf.
If you are worried your criminal history could prevent you from getting this license, Texas allows you to have your criminal history evaluated before submitting your application and non-refundable fees. To request a criminal history evaluation, submit a Criminal History Evaluation Letter, a completed Criminal History Questionnaire form for each crime you were convicted of or placed on deferred adjudication for and a \$25 fee. 10. DISCIPLINARY ACTION HISTORY – Indicate if you have ever had a professional license, certification, or registration suspended, canceled, revoked, or denied in any state. If Yes, complete and attach a Disciplinary Action Questionnaire for each disciplinary action. This form can be obtained from the TDLR website at [www.tdlr.texas.gov/misc/Disciplinary Action Questionnaire.pdf](http://www.tdlr.texas.gov/misc/Disciplinary_Action_Questionnaire.pdf).
11. STATEMENT OF APPLICANT – Carefully read the statement before dating and signing your application.
