

Summary of Proposed Rule Changes

The Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation proposes changes to the rules at 16 TAC, Chapter 98, Motorcycle Operator Training and Safety.

What are the proposed rule changes?

The proposed rule changes:

- Require applicants for a motorcycle instructor license to submit their fingerprints for a national criminal history background check;
- Allow instructor training courses to be conducted at any motorcycle school by a person who holds an instructor training provider license;
- Provide the eligibility requirements, responsibilities, and fees for an instructor training provider license; and
- Require motorcycle schools to report each injury instead of each incident where the motorcycle falls to the ground.
