## Applications Available For Membership On 13 TDLR Boards and Councils

**AUSTIN** – The Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation is seeking applicants for membership on 13 advisory boards and councils to provide knowledge and insight to some of the agency’s 39 licensing programs.

Most vacancies are for public members who do not have a connection to the industry of their appointed board. Public members provide valuable insight as citizens of Texas. Other boards are seeking members to specifically serve as industry representatives. These board members provide the agency with advice based on their technical knowledge and experience as professionals in their field. Most terms are for six years, while other terms are shorter, due to a seat vacated by a member who was unable to complete their term.

Advisory board members are appointed by the chairman of the Texas Commission on Licensing and Regulation. There is no financial compensation for membership.
