TDLR Lists Recently Revoked Licenses

Complete TDLR list available online – Check that license before hiring someone

AUSTIN –The Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation has revoked 12 licenses and issued two cease and desist orders since November for individuals who are not authorized to perform certain licensed services in Texas, including air conditioning and refrigeration, barbering, cosmetology, electricians, massage therapy and vehicle storage facilities.

Among the types of violations that would cause a license to be revoked or that would cause TDLR to issue a cease-and-desist order or a permanent injunction: engaging in fraudulent activity; being convicted of a criminal offense that directly relates to the duties and responsibilities of the licensed occupation; performing services without having the appropriate license; or making false statements to obtain a license.

TDLR reminds consumers that people working in professions and industries without the proper license can pose a risk to your health, your safety, and your wallet. The agency urges consumers not to hire unlicensed service providers.

Before you hire someone, always check with TDLR (<https://www.tdlr.texas.gov/LicenseSearch/>) first to make sure that person is licensed. Most TDLR licensees are glad to provide their licensing information to consumers for verification.

Some individuals or businesses on this list may be able to reapply for a license after one year; others are permanently banned from reapplying for or holding a license in Texas.
