

Enforcement Division Staff Report September 30, 2016

Case Highlights

- On March 28, an agreed order was entered against South Texas Fighting Championships assessing an administrative penalty of \$1,500 for failing to have ticket prices printed on tickets and failing to have tickets torn in half with one half being saved for review of the Department.
- On April 21, an agreed order was entered against RCI Dining Services, Inc. assessing an administrative penalty of \$3,000 for acting as a combative sports promoter without a license.
- On May 2, an agreed order was entered against Kevin Ferguson Sr. assessing an administrative penalty of \$2,500 and revoking the boxer license for testing positive for a prohibited substance before a bout.
- On June 27, an agreed order was entered against Joe Zamora assessing an administrative penalty of \$1,500 for failing to honor the terms of a contract for an event.
- On July 27, an agreed order was entered against Kenneth Shamrock assessing an administrative penalty of \$2,500 and revoking the boxer license for testing positive for a prohibited substance before a bout.
